

2019 Showman of Showman Rules

1. Market Goat, Market Lamb, Market Feeder Calf, Market Steer, Market Poultry, Market Rabbit, Market Swine, Jr. Fair Dairy, and Jr. Fair Horse Grand Champion Showman Participants are qualified to show in this class.
2. The 2019 Showman of Showman Representative will not be eligible to participate the following year (2020). The previous winner (2018) must be present to pass out the trophy to the new winner (2019).
3. Each specie representative has a choice to accept or decline the Showman of Showman nomination. If he/she declines the nomination, the Reserve Champion Participant of that species may accept this nomination.
 - i. If a child wins with more than one species, he/she will choose which species to represent and the Reserve of the opposite specie will then be chosen to compete. There will be an exception if there is no Reserve. In this case, the representative must show the specie that has no Reserve.
 - ii. If Grand and Reserve both decline, there will be no one to represent that specie in the Showman of Showman class.
4. Each participant will show each species of market animals – goat, lamb, feeder, chicken, hog, Jr. Fair dairy, horse and rabbit. There will be a class for each individual species of animal listed above. This will make a total of eight classes overall in the competition.
5. Participants are responsible to find their own animal to show in each class, and have permission from the child who loans it. Each participant needs to sign and turn in a permission slip to show, as well as complete and turn in a card stating which animals they will be using in the show. There will be an exception with horses, Jr. Fairboard/horse committee will preselect a horse to be used for the competition.
6. Participants will not show their own animal or sibling's animal in any of the eight classes. All animals used in the competition must be clean and presentable.
7. Judging will be based on a point system one through eleven. The participant with the lowest number score will be the Showman of Showman Winner. If there is a tie with the lowest number score, a tie breaking question from the judge will determine the overall winner.
8. The dress code for the competition will be long pants, button up shirt, and boots. Chicken and rabbit exhibitors do not have to wear white coats.
