PURPOSE

In order to help young people continue their efforts toward becoming self-directing, productive, and contributing members of society, the Meigs County Agricultural Society has established a Scholarship opportunity for current Seniors in High School who have participated in the Meigs County Fair and plan to further their education in the future.

CRITERIA FOR BASIS OF AWARD

The following consideration will be given in the selection of a scholarship recipient:

1. He/she must have the admission application on file in the Office of Admissions of the college of their choice by March 1st.
2. He/she must have been a Junior Fair exhibitor in Meigs County.
3. He/she should have a 2.5 CGPA in high school and must be a graduating high school senior.
4. Consideration will be given toward the participation of the student in civic or co-curricular activities.
5. These scholarships must be used at a college or university accredited by the North Central Association or similar associations in other regions.
6. The application should be typewritten using Arial 11 point font. You must maintain ½ inch left and right margins using the formatted application.
7. Applicants must submit the following stapled and single sided in the upper left corner (no tabbed dividers, coversheets, or any type of folder/binder): A) Completed Application; B) Current high school transcript including ACT scores; C) Current photograph of applicant on separate page with name and address below photo
