

2024 Project Completion Guidelines

Companion Animals and Dogs

General Requirements

- Member must participate in Project Interviews (Judging Day or Early Interviews) with a complete project book for the project to be considered completed for the 4-H year.
- Member must participate in a Project Interview during Judging Day to be eligible to be considered for Ohio State Fair Selection.
- Member must display a representation of their project in their 4-H club fair booth.
- All members should be prepared to know general 4-H information.
- **Members should NOT bring their animals to judging unless they take You and Your Dog, Dog Obedience, Dog Performance, Dog Showmanship, Working Dogs, and Dog Achievement Program.**

Dog

1. All 8 activities
2. All Talking it Over questions.
3. At least 2 learning experiences.
4. At least 2 leadership/citizenship activities.
5. Project Review.
6. Bring to judging:
 - a. Completed project book.
 - b. A display (does not need to be a trifold/poster) representing the learning experience of the project.

Dog Project and Record Book

1. Project goals.
2. Member Project Guide, Dog Care and Welfare, and Animal Records sections.
3. Bring to judging:
 - a. Completed project book.
 - b. A display (does not need to be a trifold/poster) representing the learning experience of the project.

Assistance Animals in Action

1. All 8 activities
2. All Talking it Over questions.
3. At least 2 learning experiences.
4. At least 2 leadership/citizenship activities.
5. Project Review.
6. Bring to judging:
 - c. Completed project book.
 - d. A display (does not need to be a trifold/poster) representing the learning experience of the project.

Cats

Purr-fect Pals, Level 1; Climbing Up! Level 2; Leaping Forward, Level 3

1. Cat-a-logue Your Knowledge evaluation, before and after project.
2. At least 7 activities.
3. Completed Project Review and attached Feed Tag.
4. Bring to judging:
 - a. Completed project book.
 - b. A display (does not need to be a trifold/poster) representing the learning experience of the project.

Cavy

Cavy Project and Record Book

1. Project goals and objectives.
2. Member Project Guide, animal care and welfare activities, and animal records.
3. At least 5 of the learning activities.
4. At least 2 learning experiences.
5. At least 2 leadership/citizenship activities.
6. Completed Project Review and attached Feed Tag.
7. Bring to judging:
 - a. Completed project book.
 - b. A display (does not need to be a trifold/poster) representing the learning experience of the project.

Pet Rabbit

Rabbit Project and Record Book

1. At least 5 learning activities.
2. At least 2 learning experiences.
3. At least 1 topic of interest.
4. At least 2 leadership/citizenship activities.
5. Animal Records, Financial Records, and Quality Assurance sections.
6. Bring to judging:
 - a. Completed project book (**make sure to only complete the pet rabbit sections**).
 - b. A display (does not need to be a trifold/poster) representing the learning experience of the project.

Pet Rabbit

Pocket Pets

1. Project Goals and Objectives.
2. Member Project Guide, animal care and welfare activities, and animal records.
3. Other animal project records.
4. At least 5 learning activities.
5. At least 2 learning experiences.
6. At least 2 leadership/citizenship activities.
7. Bring to judging:
 - a. Completed project book.
 - b. A display (does not need to be a trifold/poster) representing the learning experience of the project.

Ohio State Fair Exhibition

- Selections for the Ohio State Fair will be made during the Meigs County Judging Day and based on Meigs County Project Completion Requirements.
- Not everyone who wins first or second place will be eligible for Ohio State Fair selection. This is based on the judge's decision.
- All About Dogs, Assistance Animals in Action, Cavy Project and Record Book, Purr-fect Pals, Climbing Up!, Leaping Forward, Pocket Pets Project and Record Book all exhibit at the Ohio State Fair at the Companion Animal Day.
- Pet Rabbit does not have a state fair event.
- The Dog Project and Record Book is a show at the Ohio State Fair, it is not a regular "judging day".
