## Fair 2019

### August 11-17, 2019

- **Booth spaces and Hospitality tent information is attached to this email. Make sure you check those out!!**
- **Parade applications are attached to this email!! They are to be returned to Jenna NO LATER than July 29, 2019.**
- **This year we would like for each club to make up a gift basket (example on page 1) worth \$25 that will be used in a silent auction to raise money for 4-H clinics/workshops for next year.**

- Meeting requirements – We are getting close to judging, fair, and finishing up our 4-H year! To make sure that you remain a member in good standing and are eligible to compete, your club leaders will be checking attendance at meetings. Each club is required to hold at least 6 meetings, and each member is required to attend at least 4 of those. If you do not meet this requirement, you will not receive any awards, and will not be able to show any livestock at the Fair under 4-H. If you know you are close, check with your advisor!
- Swine Showmen – you may be hearing some reports from neighboring states about quarantine orders being set. Pennsylvania Dept of Agriculture has put some additional controls in place to help stop swine disease spread. The specific concern at this point is African Swine Fever, which has not been found in the US but would have devastating results if it were found here. Ohio has not made any changes yet, but it is something that is on their radar and we have been getting updates. We cannot change the world around us, but we can take steps to limit risks to our animals through basic biohazard precautions, including:
  - Hand hygiene;
  - Limit travel of animals, humans, and supplies between barns containing livestock;
  - Cleaning and disinfecting surfaces and equipment;
  - Isolating diseased animals;
  - Disposing of infected tissues or dead animals appropriately; and
  - Controlling the infestation of pests which can be carriers of infectious agents (mice, birds, raccoons, etc.).
